

DELEGATES TO CENTRAL DISTRICT CONFERENCE AND INDIANA MICHIGAN MENNONITE CONFERENCE

Purpose: To represent our congregation at the regional conferences and represent the conference to the congregation.

Composition: Delegates usually include pastors, representation from Leadership Group, and 2-4 congregational delegates.

Term:

1. Delegates serve two year terms, with option to continue if interested.
2. Members nominated by self or others, affirmed by congregation.
3. Accountable to Leadership Group.

Responsibilities:

1. Attend regional meeting in winter and annual conference meeting in summer each year.
2. Report to congregation as needed.

Time involved: Day-long regional meeting in winter, 3-day annual meeting in summer.

Qualifications:

1. Active participant in the congregation.
2. Familiarity with congregation with ability to accurately represent congregation at meetings.
3. Have interest in and experience with conference activities.
