

## WINDOWS

### To obtain a sound copy of a sermon.

1. Go to the sermons on the Web site. (You need to be - or have available - an attender who knows the password and who has the ability to go through the site. - That's the hard part.) You may need to do this on a computer.

I am describing this in Windows 10.

2. Have a place (directory) to store the file, and know how to get to it.
3. Pick your sermon. The list is in the format: # presentation-type date name  
e.g. 5. Sermon 2012-05-23 George Assemblyite.
4. Right-click on it.
5. A list appears. Left-click on Save link as .
6. Tell it where. (#2 above.)
7. Left click on Save .
8. It is now in your computer as a file with .mp3 format.

## MAC

### To obtain a sound copy of a sermon.

1. Go to the sermons on the Web site. (You need to be - or have available - an attender who knows the password and who has the ability to go through the site. - That's the hard part.) You may need to do this on a computer.

I am describing this in **Mac OSX**.

2. Pick your sermon. The list is in the format: # presentation-type date name  
e.g. 5. Sermon 2012-05-23 George Assemblyite.

3. **Control**-click on it.
4. A list appears. (a) **Control-clicking on it will save it to Downloads folder.** (b) **Save link as ~ will allow you to save it to the desktop or any folder of your choice.**
5. Tell it where. (**#4 (b)** above.)
6. It is now in your computer as a file with `.mp3` format.
