Responsibilities of all pastors:

- 1. Spend time in prayer, Bible study, and other spiritual formation practices, listening for the Spirit's leading.
- 2. Attend to the spiritual health, vibrancy, and direction of the congregation.
- 3. Meet with committees and other groups related to your ministry focus.
- 4. Provide pastoral care to Assembly participants.*
- 5. Preach occasionally as fits Assembly's participatory worship model.
- 6. Lead communion and other elements of worship.*
- 7. Plan elders' retreats.
- 8. Oversee interns.*
- 9. Attend church-wide conferences and participate in wider-church events as appropriate.*
- 10. Work within one's allotted hours to the extent possible.

Specific assignments pastor of community building and mission -- Karl (.65 FTE)

- 1. Give leadership in mission and peace & justice advocacy:
 - Root this emphasis in biblical faith; Facilitate congregational peace & justice education and advocacy; Make connections with outside prophetic witness.
- 2. Make connections in the broader church and community on initiatives consistent with Assembly's mission.
- 3. Give leadership to small groups:
 - Root this emphasis in biblical faith; Lead monthly reps meeting; Facilitate small group inclusion; Shape congregational material for small group processing; Oversee covenanting to the congregation; Monitor and strengthen small group life.
- 4. Give leadership to congregational discernment and planning:
 - Help shape discernment processes; Facilitate congregational meetings and consensus decision-making; Work with congregational goal-setting.
