Jodi Beyeler: moderator

- 1. Welcome, Introduction (Jodi)
- 2. Discernment, first reading: <u>2022 Spending Plan</u> (Larry)
- This is a first draft, no decision on it tonight
- John showed us the pledge and giving history, and total giving
  - Note that we have thus far paid off the mortgage at a significantly faster rate than expected, so we will likely be able to pay it off 10 years early
- Larry spoke about the budget/spending plan
  - \$40,000 in reserve fund
  - About \$5000 in balance at end of year
  - Safety Networks "healthy" balance of about \$15,000
  - Members Needs \$16,000 also healthy
  - Overall excellent giving in 2021 and we're in good shape
  - 85% inside Assembly expenses, 15% outside Assembly expenses (note that we prefer those percentages to tip more in favor of "outside" and as we pay the mortgage down, that is what's happening)
  - The amount planned for staff salaries seems unexpectedly low to some people, considering that we'll be hiring an administrative assistant
    - John will double-check that amount
  - There was some discussion about the fact that we have budgeted money for the Peace & Justice Support Network, which no longer exists
    - The Leadership Committee will look into that and resolve it, with the assistance of the Finance Committee (suggestions welcome)
    - One possibility is the Dismantling the Doctrine of Discovery
- 3. Information: Updated Safe Church Documents (Lora)
- This is information sharing, no decision to be made tonight
- Thanks to the committee that worked on the revision of these documents
- We began this revision because our insurance company requested that we have a protocol for situations in which we have a registered sex offender at Assembly
- Major change (new document in response to that request)
  - response to a participant credibly accused of sexual misconduct
    - note that this broadens the scope beyond just registered sex offenders
  - survivor-centered
- Includes guidance on being safe digitally

- Essentially same as in person (example: children's group hosted on Zoom includes minimum of 2 adults)
- We will now review these documents on an annual basis
- 4. Information: Update on Pastor Congregation Review process (Lois)
  - 2015 was last (regular) review
    - the gap between then and now is due to changes in the pastoral team
    - $\circ$  the Bridge Support Team completed work that counted as the review in 2018
  - Purpose is to support and nurture relationships of trust among pastors and congregation
  - 3 principles that guide the committee: curiosity, mutual care, humility
    - Congregation should use those principles as well as they review this
  - Congregation response/participation
    - Feb. 10 deadline
    - Can be done online, in an in-person conversation group, or in hard copy
      - Let Lois know if you'd like to be involved in an in-person conversation group or would like a hard copy
  - This review process is done about every 3 years
- 5. Information: Anna Yoder Schlabach's Ordination (Randy)
  - Process: individual is called, then licensed, then walks in that ministry for a number of years, then recommended for ordination
  - Anna is now being (highly) recommended for ordination

6. Information: Update on Hiring of Administrative Assistant (Scott)

- Two internal applicants were interviewed recently, both were excellent
- Becky Overholt has been hired as the new administrative assistant
  - Will likely begin in the beginning of February
- 7. Closing: Pastoral prayer (Scott)
