Parables of Luke Bible Study

October 3 - November 21



This year, for our annual fall Bible study, the worship committee chose to take a closer look at some of the parables found in the book of Luke. Our last series on *Seeking Justice* began with Luke 4 and Jesus' proclamation that the Spirit of the Lord had anointed him to preach good news to the poor, proclaim release and recovery.

The parables of Luke are one way of answering the question: What does justice look like in the Kingdom of God? It looks like mustard seeds and dishonest managers, lost sheep and persistent widows. How might these familiar stories sound different to us in this moment? Amy-Jill Levine, in her book "Short stories by Jesus" writes, "Too often we settle for easy interpretations, we should be nice like the good Samaritan, we will be forgiven as will the prodigal son, we should pray and not lose heart like the importuning widow... If we stop with the easy lessons, we lose the way Jesus' first followers would have heard the parables, and we lose the genius of Jesus' teaching. We might be better off thinking less about what they "mean" and more about what they can "do": remind, provoke, refine, confront, disturb..." How might the parables of Jesus help us to see the world in a different way, to be challenged and perhaps even indicted? What might they reveal to us about the Kingdom of God? And how can we playfully hear these stories anew?

We will continue to worship at 9:30am in the parking lot for this series as long as the weather is tolerable. Sunday school for youth and children will begin after worship, and will last for 30 minutes. Adults are encouraged to stick around and drink coffee during Sunday school.

If the weather prevents us from meeting in the parking lot, the worship service will be livestreamed on Zoom at 9:30, and Sunday school will still happen at the meetinghouse from 11-11:30am.
